The BM TRADA Q-Mark Enhanced Security Schemes centre on the requirements of PAS 23 & 24 and as such are also accepted by Secured by Design. Ali Systems has in addition achieved the BM TRADA Q-mark for General Performance Windows.

Mr Denmark added, 'We decided to target the Q-Mark to set ourselves further apart from competitors, A key aspect of all the Q-Mark schemes is audit testing, which means that any product selected at random from the production line must pass the same requirements as the products initially type tested. Achieving Q-Mark means that we can state categorically that our products will perform time after time.'
